

## **General Course Rules**

EXE LAS MARGAS GOLF CLUB HAS A CODE OF CONDUCT THAT SHOULD BE KNOWN AND FOLLOWED TO ENSURE THE CORRECT RUNNING OF THE GAME AND GUARANTEE RESPECT FOR OTHER PLAYERS AND CLUB FACILITIES.

## **General Rules**

- 1. Any player who uses the sports facilities at Exe Las Margas Golf Club must know and follow the Rules of Golf, the Rules of the Spanish Golf Federations and the Rules of Etiquette. Not knowing them will not mean any mitigation.
- 2. Golfers must listen to and respect the instructions they receive from Club employees, since they, in the performance of their duties, represent the Management Bodies and their mission is to enforce the instructions they provide.

## Maintenance and care of the course

- 3. Replace divots in the fairway and in the tees.
- 4. Rake the bunkers and then put the rake back in its proper place.
- 5. Fix the ball impacts on the green.
- 6. Mark the balls on the greens with suitable markers or coins avoiding marking the ball or tearing the green with tees or other sharp objects.
- 7. Do not deform the hole when removing or replacing the flag. To this end, avoid taking the ball from out of the hole with the putter.
- 8. Do not perform test swings by making divots, especially on tees and fairways.
- 9. Playing with practice balls is strictly forbidden, resulting in the expulsion of the course and losing the right to claim the green fee back.
- 10. Approaching the putting green is strictly forbidden.
- 11. Use the bins along the course and keep your buggy clean.

## **Access and mobility rules**

- 12. Golfers must follow the instructions regarding cars and carts and walk along the established paths.
- 13. Cars must be occupied by a maximum of 2 people and may not be driven by children under 16.
- 14. Entering the marls is strictly forbidden. If your ball falls in the marls (hole 2), you can't recover it.
- 15. Follow the rules of courtesy, maintain an appropriate playing pace without delaying other games, and if needed, give way.
- 16. Mark the ball in every par 3 in case there are other players waiting at the tee.
